

Yellow Tomato Leaves

Common causes and solutions



New plants:

- This is normal
- Pick off bottom yellow leaves



Nutrients missing:

- Test to see what is lacking
- Treat appropriately



Watering issues:

- Under-watering causes dry yellow leaves
- Over-watering causes droopy, limp leaves



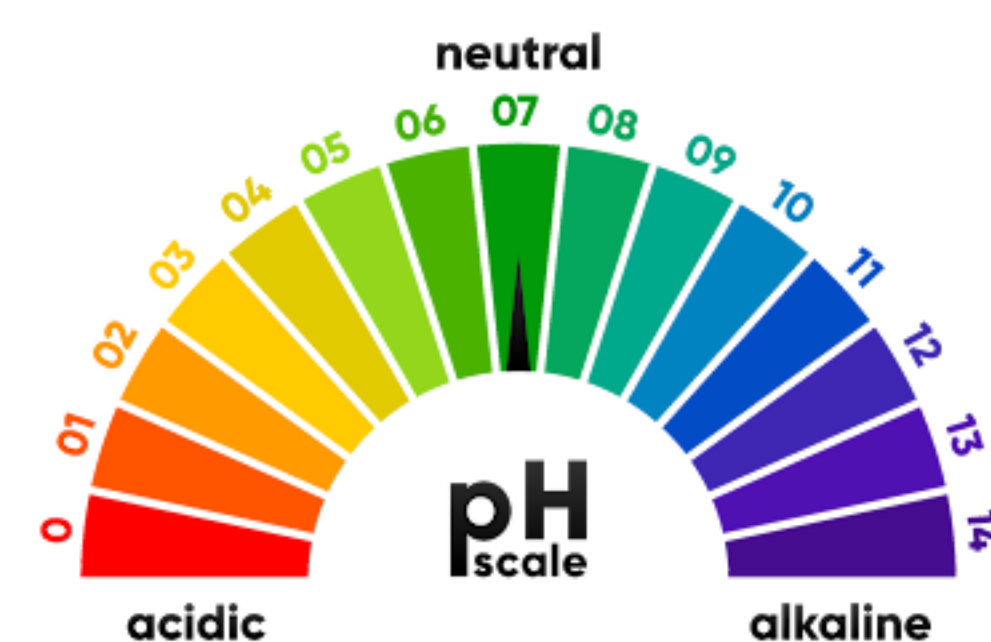
Fertilizer burn:

- Don't over-feed plants
- Follow package directions exactly



Too much sunlight:

- Use shade cloth to protect plants
- Water consistently in hot weather



Soil pH problems

- Test soil with a meter
- 6.2-6.8 is preferred soil pH



Herbicides:

- Plants are sensitive to weed killers
- Pull weeds by hand, instead



Fungal diseases:

- Contact your local department of Agriculture for treatment options



End of season:

- Yellow leaves are normal
- Harvest fruits and dispose of plant
