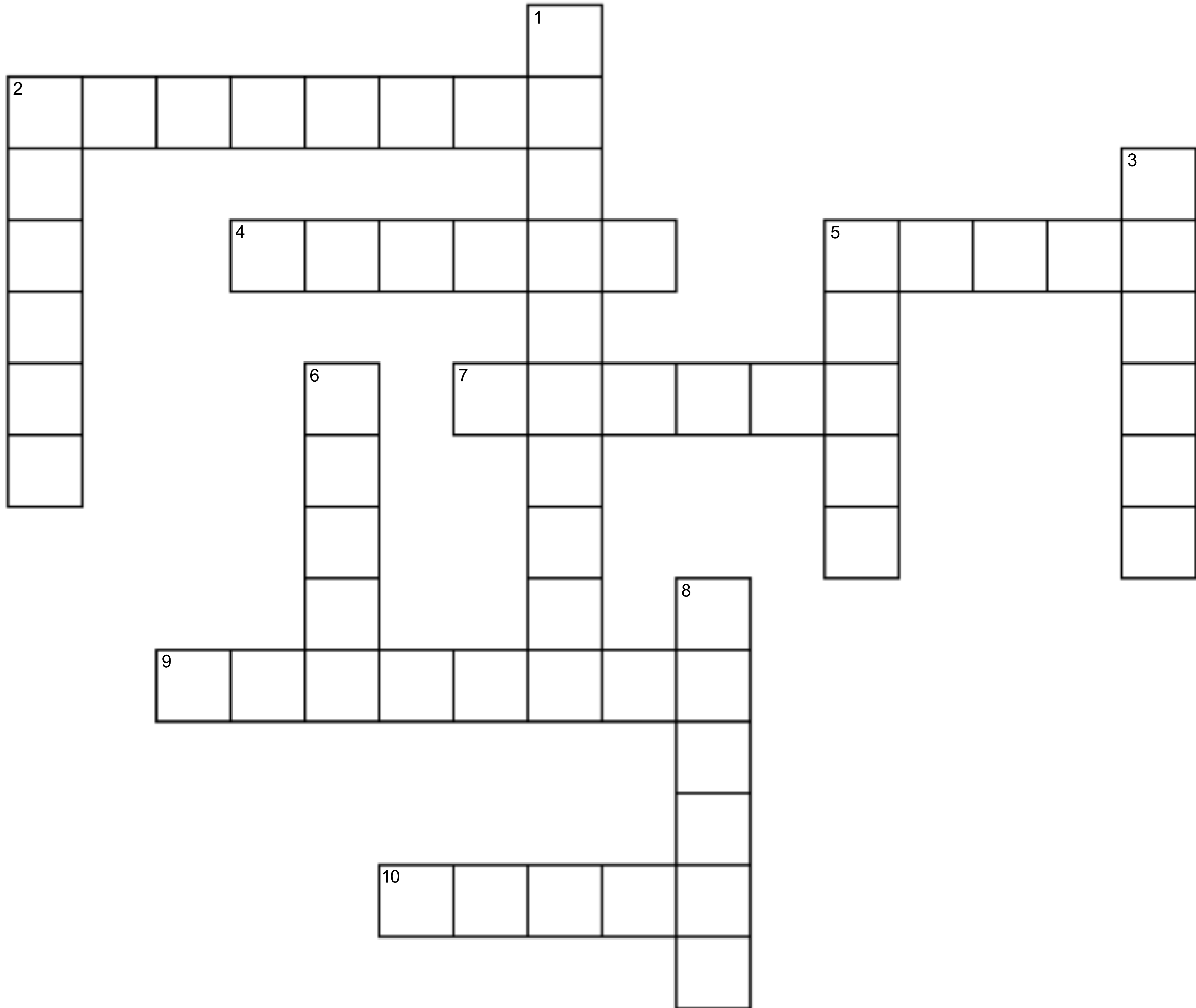


FLOWER PARTS

DOWN:

1. The top of the flower stalk which is connected to the other parts of the flower.
2. The female reproductive organ of a flower.
3. Brightly colored parts of the flower that attract pollinators & protect the flower's reproductive parts.
5. The base of the pistil that produces a flower's ovules.
6. The green, leaf-like outer part of a flower that protect it in the bud stage.
8. The male reproductive organ of a flower.

ACROSS:

2. The main stem of a flower.
4. The part of the stamen that produces pollen.
5. Located inside the ovary; when successfully pollinated and fertilized, it becomes a seed.
7. The part of the pistil that captures pollen (often sticky or covered in small hairs).
9. Thin stalk in the stamen that holds up a flower's anther.
10. A slender stalk of the pistil that connects the stigma to the ovary.
