



Heartleaf Philodendron Plant Care Guide



Light

Bright, indirect light is ideal;
Tolerates lower light conditions



Watering

Water when the top 1-2" of soil is dry;
Too much water can lead to root rot



Fertilizer

Feed with a balanced fertilizer during
active growth in spring and summer



Soil

Use well-draining soil;
Be sure pot has a drainage hole



Temperature

Likes warm indoor environments:
65°F to 80°F (18°C to 27°C)



Repotting

Repot when roots fill the soil;
Use a pot 1-2 inches larger



Pruning

Prune long or unruly vines;
Cut stems just above a leaf node



Toxicity

Toxic to cats and dogs;
Keep away from pets that like to chew
